**NOTICE OF THE CUT-OFF DATE OF 26<sup>th</sup> APRIL 2019, FOR LAND AND PROPERTY SURVEYS FOR LAND  
ACQUISITION AND DEVELOPMENTS WITHIN THE PROPOSED POWER LINE CORRIDOR**

The Electricity Supply Corporation of Malawi Limited (ESCOM) with assistance from the Government of the Republic of Malawi intends to construct a 400 kV transmission power line from the existing Matambo substation (Changara District, Tete Province, Mozambique) to the existing Phombeya substation (Balaka District, Southern Region, Malawi). The project will be implemented with financial and technical support from the World Bank, Norwegian Trust Fund, KfW, European Union(EU) and the Southern African Power Pool (SAPP).

The project is part of an ongoing regional energy integration process, with the objective to promote and enhance electricity trade with neighbouring countries, and improve the power security and reliability of supply on Malawi's Network. In Malawi, the project will require the construction of a 400 kV power transmission line over 76 km, crossing the districts of Balaka, (TA Nsamala), Neno (TAs Symon and Mlauli), and Mwanza (TAs Kanduku and Nthache), as well as construction of access and maintenance roads along the power line.

The Project technical characteristics will be the following:

- Width of wayleave under the line: 55 m
- Tower spacing: 450 m
- Tower height: 44 to 53 m
- Tower base: 20 m x 20 m

This **communiqué** serves as a notice to all the Project Affected Persons (PAPs), local leaders, all community members and the general public that the last day for affected land and property surveys for the project will be on Friday **26<sup>th</sup> April 2019**.

All those with any land related queries, or anomalies are encouraged to meet with the project team members who will be on site in the affected villages to finalise the survey between **6<sup>th</sup> April 2019 to 26<sup>th</sup> April 2019**.

Please note that after the **Cut Off Date of 26<sup>th</sup> April 2019**, no permanent developments or improvements will be allowed within the demarcated area and way leave. Any new property constructed within the demarcated and surveyed area after **26<sup>th</sup> April 2019** will not be compensated for Land Acquisition for the Mozambique-Malawi Interconnection Project.
